Public invited to see final recommendation for Jerome County Airport Improvements

Public Open House: Wednesday, Dec. 14 (4-5:30 pm) at Precision Aviation

JEROME - The Jerome County Airport (JER) is concluding a Master Plan Update to plan future facilities and identify improvement alternatives including increased runway length.

The public is invited to learn more about the recommended final improvements at a public open house: **Wednesday, Dec. 14 from 4-5:30 pm at Precision Aviation**, 472 Highway 25, Hangar 20 at the Jerome County Airport, near the front entrance.

The study is scheduled for completion in 2023. This planning effort will update the existing 2012 Airport Layout Plan (ALP). Since 2012, demand at the Airport has changed, and with it, the need for increased runway length and a development area plan for new hangars, apron space, and amenities.

The master plan update process includes analyzing existing airport uses and facilities, forecasting future demands, and considering available land use options. The results of this analysis have produced short, intermediate, and long-term recommendations to the Airport and the Federal Aviation Authority (FAA).

After the open house, throughout the winter, informational stations will be posted at the Airport Pilot's Lounge.
